Why is Chula Vista a Promise Neighborhood?

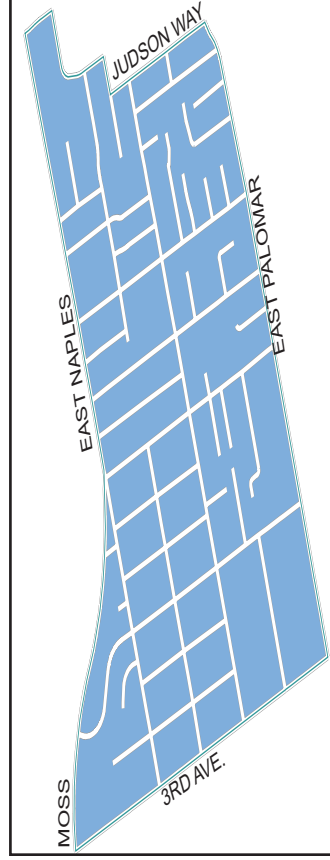
